Upcoming Local Government Elections: If you are eligible to be on the state electoral roll but are not correctly enrolled, you can:

- Visit the Australian Electoral Commission website https://www.aec.gov.au/enrol/
- Get an enrolment form from any post office, or ring 1800 801 701 and ask for one to be mailed to you.

If you are not eligible to be on the state electoral roll, you are eligible to be on the Local Government roll if:

- You own or occupy land in a municipal area different from where you are enrolled on the state electoral roll, or
- You are the nominated representative of a corporate body which owns or occupies land in the municipal area.

To enrol under these special provisions, you need to apply to be added to the General Manager's roll and complete the appropriate enrolment form. Application forms are available from Council's front office.

Local Government Election roles close on Thursday 13 September at 6 pm.
