I refer to the advertising in the above matter for an extension to the existing dwelling on Little Dog Island.

I own the adjoining block to the South.

I have no objection to the proposed development and it does not impact on my property.

It is a positive for the island environment that the septic system is proposed to be upgraded.

In terms of the siting and form, it is unlikely that such a dwelling would be approved today given it is just a few metres from the boundary, the pitched roof extends above the ridgeline behind and the white colour dominates the landscape and is viewable from Badger Corner to Lady Barron.

However, in the context of the existing building on the site it is not unreasonable to update and extend by 25% as permitted by the planning scheme.

Nonetheless there is an opportunity for some relatively minor, inexpensive permit conditions which would make a big impact on the visual impact of the dwelling.

1. Paint the whole house in a darker colour in accordance with the requirements that would be imposed today under the Landscape Conservation zone ie

"Exterior building finishes must have a light reflectance value not more than 40%, in dark natural tones of grey, green or brown"

2. Plant some native vegetation such as she-oaks in front of the dwelling.

These are suggestions to improve the proposal only and I do not object to the Application in substance.
