Redesign in progress;<br>Mowing of grassed areas and weed spraying;<br>Sweeping of both runways and main apron;<br>Continued drainage upgrade works to all areas;<br>Maintenance to aircraft grassed parking areas;<br>Standby power generator fortnightly checks;<br>Review of airport emergency plan;<br>Re-fuelling of aircraft as required;<br>Trees cleared behind private hangars and area cleared and levelled prior to erecting new fence; and<br>Employee on long-term sick leave has returned to work. |
