1 DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this Instrument of Delegation, the following terms have the following meanings unless the contrary intention appears:

'Act'	means the <i>Local Government Act 1993</i> as may be amended, varied or replaced from time to time;
'Council'	means the Flinders Council established pursuant to s.18 of the Act;
'General Manager'	means the person appointed to the position of general manager of the Council pursuant to s.61 of the <i>Local Government Act</i> 1993; and
'Officer'	means an employee of Council.

2 REVOCATION OF PREVIOUS DELEGATIONS

Pursuant to s.23AA(2)(c) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1931, Council hereby revokes all previous delegations made and approved by the Council.

3 DELEGATIONS
