NOTES FROM THE MAYOR

WHAT IS COUNCIL DOING TO AIRFARES?

Council is adding passenger tax and landing fee costs to a <u>total of \$3.50 per ticket</u>. I have no idea how Mal Sharp got this so wrong! You will remember that Senator Steve Martin announced last April that Flinders would receive a funding grant for \$1.8 million for the long runway upgrade. The total runway upgrade costs \$3.6 million. Council has to find the gap amount by itself - \$1.8 million – a huge amount for our small council!

COUNCIL'S MEETINGS WITH STATE CABINET WERE VERY FRUITFUL

Our whole council are so appreciative of our meetings with State Cabinet. We talked with Cabinet about all of the challenges we currently face, they listened so well and agreed to support us in so many ways. One of our issues of course is the airport. The airport runs at a loss of \$250,000 per year. It is too much for Council and yet it is so necessary for our Island's community. Safe Harbour is another major challenge. However, we are confident that the next few months working with Government will offer us several key options. We will begin working on these matters very soon - we will also be engaging with you, our community. You will help us make the appropriate decisions I am sure.

RECRUITMENT OF A CONTRACTED GENERAL MANAGER Is underway, but we are taking it relatively slowly. Council passed at the last ordinary meeting that we will engage in a partial in-house recruitment process. This means that we will engage our Human Resources consultant to place adverts, receive applications, and other tasks, as they arise. Council will assess the applications and interview the short-listed applicants. We will do our utmost to select the best applicant, for your sake and for ours!

THE FLINDERS ECONOMIC, BUSINESS AND SOCIAL REVIEW was recently published. The Review provides a review of the cost of the Island's isolation. The community has always known that isolation has a price. However this Review enables us to quantify the isolation: eg Households on Flinders earn between \$350 and \$600 less than households elsewhere in Tasmania and Australia. In addition, it costs us more to live here due to freight costs mainly. This document will enable Council to make improved claims for government grants. The review is available online for any community member who would like a copy. Ring Council reception and a downloaded copy will make its way to you.

CABINET GAVE US LOTS OF INFORMATION ON WHAT WE CAN DO TO ENSURE ENOUGH HOUSING ON THE ISLAND Council has recently formed a Housing Working Party jointly with FIAAI and FIBI, others may participate at times also. In the very near future the working party will be exploring the various options for improving the availability of affordable housing on the Island. Rachel Summers, Vanessa Grace and Sharon Blyth are the councillors on the committee. We will definitely keep you informed once we are further down the track.

DO YOU KNOW THAT COUNCIL MEETING AGENDAS COST \$11,000?

Council is going on a saving spree! Councillors are going to make better use of their computers in order to save money on printing. Additionally, only digital copies will be made available to the community. If you would like a digital copy sent to you, please ring Council to arrange.
