SCAN ME

A valid park pass is required for entry to all of Tasmania's national parks.

CAMPING & FACILITIES

FLINDERS ISLAND INFORMATION

WATER

Water is potable in Lady Barron and Whitemark only. There is a tap for use at the Whitemark Showgrounds and the BBQ area in Whitemark to replenish your supplies. Rainwater tanks are installed at most of the camping sites, however, the water is untreated.

DUMP EZY

A Dump Ezy station is available for use at Whitemark Showgrounds- Palana Road. Turn left behind main buildings near the toilet amenities block.

CAMPFIRES

It is currently a total fire ban on the Furneaux Islands in all campsites and reserves. Fires are NOT permitted in any of these areas. Fines will be issued - no exceptions.

BBQ FACILITIES

Free BBQ facilities are available around the island. Please ensure BBQ facilities are left clean after use.

POWER

When camping on Flinders Island, you need to be self-sufficient. There are NO powered camping sites. If you need to recharge batteries - an option would be to stay in one of the accommodation houses for an evening. Enjoy some creature comforts and recharge.

LAUNDROMAT

Located in Lagoon Rd, Whitemark - Building to left of Nutrien Ag Solutions. Walk down left side of building and look for the sign. Takes \$1 coins only.

BOOKINGS

There are no facilities to prebook camping areas. It is a matter of first in best dressed. A National Parks Pass is available from Service Tas or bring yours with you.

SAFETY

Look up. Avoid camping under trees branches and trees may fall unpredictably. Take extra care in hot or windy weather or during severe weather events. Observe all warning signs and stay well away from trees that appear to be dead or have dead branches.



RUBBISH

Skip bins are located at Transfer Stations on Palana Rd just north of the Killiecrankie turn off and on Lady Barron Rd just outside the town boundary of Lady Barron. Transfer Stations are open 24/7
