Hello Denise,

I have wanted for some time to acknowledge the contribution of the servicemen of Cape Barren Island to the First World War. You are probably aware that of the relatively small population of your Island at that time, eighteen men enlisted and fought in that War, and five were either killed in action or died of their wounds. By any standards, that was a monumental commitment towards the freedom of our country, and I would wish, with the permission of your community, to acknowledge that fact on ANZAC Day next year.

Again, with your permission, I would like to take a small delegation, including a bugler (to play the last post and reveille) and a guest speaker,

to The Corner for the Dawn Service on 25th of April, and, after breakfast, transport any members of your community who wishes to go, by charter boat or by aircraft, to attend the March and 11AM ANZAC Service at Whitemark. Following the service, I wish to hold a free BBQ lunch at the Whitemark foreshore for both our communities to enjoy, before returning your people to their home in the afternoon, at your discretion.

As the upcoming Ordinary Meeting of Council on 16th of October will be my last meeting, I would like to bring a Notice of Motion to Council to seek approval and funding to allow that to happen. I am seeking your approval on behalf of your community.
