The purpose of this report is to provide Councillors with an update on Infrastructure and Airport activity and works undertaken during the month of September: -

Gravel Road Resheeting Works	Nil.
Maintenance Grading	Minor.
Bitumen Road Reseal Works	Nil.
Bitumen Road Patching and Edging	Lackrana Rd Memana Rd. Lady Barron Rd.
Waste Management	Transfer of waste from Killiecrankie and Lady Barron transfer stations to Whitemark. Scheduled attendance and coverage of waste and general clean up at Whitemark landfill. Whitemark landfill attendant roster has been reorganised and is proving successful with residents.
Drainage	Lady Barron Rd table drain grading.
Mowing and Gardening	Mowing was undertaken in Lady Barron and Whitemark residential streets, parks and foreshore, Emita Hall and sports ground. Regular maintenance of the Rose Garden.
Town Maintenance	Regular ongoing cleaning and maintenance of barbeques and seating.
Building Maintenance	Regular ongoing cleaning of public halls, public toilets and gyms. The cleaning roster and responsibilities have been reorganised within the operation's staff, with further opportunities for improvement identified.
Vegetation Control	Steam weeding of various sections of footpaths and kerbing in Whitemark and Lady Barron proving to be very effective. Tree removal on Palana Rd and Cameron Inlet Rd.
Quarries	Gravel stockpiling for resheeting works.
TasWater	Weekly and monthly water testing. Meeting with TasWater to discuss work procedures.
Funerals	Nil
Airport	NOTAM in place for aircraft arriving from mainland Australia has been superseded by a national NOTAM from CASA.

	<p>Aviation fuel tank hoses, nozzles, bonding cables, bulk fuel transfer hoses and connectors inspected for certification. Renewal of some components required before certification can be issued.</p> <p>Airside Compliance areas, cones and gable markers being replaced / refurbished, 99% completed – re-painting old cones commenced.</p> <p>Mowing of runway strips and weed spraying around gable markers and cones.</p> <p>Sweeping of both runways and main apron.</p> <p>Continue drainage works to all areas.</p> <p>Magnetic gate lock issue, awaiting quote to install a new system.</p> <p>Provided induction for new Sharp Airlines employee.</p> <p>Terminal roof webcam camera failure. New webcam camera ordered and awaiting installation.</p> <p>Parks &amp; Wildlife Tasmania approved trees for removal as part of the OLS requirement and works commenced.</p> <p>ATI, OLS and EI aerodrome inspections all confirmed for November 2021.</p> <p>Terminal Car Park area re-design and works commenced, signs ordered.</p> <p>Works to terminal down-lights completed – 22 new downlights installed.</p> <p>Standby power generator fortnightly checks.</p> <p>Continue with water drainage works on the General Aviation Road.</p> <p>Removal of fire hazard trees behind new private hangers, area levelled, and grass planted, awaiting opportunity to burn-off prior to erecting a safety fence.</p> <p>Certificate 3 in Aviation Operations studies continuing.</p> <p>Certified training courses completed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-chemical certification (chemcert),</li> <li>-first aid and CPR,</li> <li>-aircraft re-fuelling.</li> </ul> <p>Fire extinguisher training.</p> <p>Awaiting return and approval of New Aerodrome manual submitted as per CASA requirement for the new MOS 139 (Manual of Standards part 139).</p> <p>Maintain COVID-19 sanitizing and cleaning of Terminal, airport vehicles, workshop and Office.</p>

Other	<p>Rip and reform trial on 200m section of Wingaroo Rd and 900m section of Melrose Rd. Staff to monitor and assess for potential future gravel road treatment.</p> <p>Fire extinguisher training for depot staff.</p> <p>First aid training for depot staff.</p> <p>Meeting with State Growth regarding work on state roads.</p>
