

### **MAYOR'S REPORT**

I'll start with the very serious issue of Fin-Fish Farming. I have received a reply from Jo Palmer MLC, Minister for Primary Industries and Water to our letter sent by David Williams. Unfortunately, Ms. Palmer reasserted the Government's commitment "to ensuring our salmon industry remains sustainable and world-leading." They feel the industry "provides a substantial economic contribution to our regional communities through employment, transport, manufacture of feed and other supplies." They re-iterated that there has been no interest thus far in finfish farming in our waters. This is the same response we have had from the Government in general. It does not mean that we stop fighting to have our waters excluded from any potential plans for fin-fish farming.

There will be another round of consultation to the 10-year Salmon Plan. Ms. Palmer has advised that Council will be contacted by NRE Officers to arrange a public presentation where we can once again voice our disapproval. In the meantime, we will continue working with groups such as Neighbours of Fish Farming to keep our waters pristine.

Now for some fun - what a time for entertainment on our island. Two weeks ago, the FIDHS School Association held their biannual Gala fundraising event (excluding the COVID years). The event was filled with fabulous entertainment, incredible food and an auction that had something for everyone. The evening was a great success and attended by over 100 supporters. I think the total profit for the night for around \$30,000 which will be used by the School Association over the next few years to help students

attend off-island events, school camps, providing on-island experiences and purchasing additional resources.

Following up that spectacular, on Saturday, Flinders Island Sports and RSL Club held a Sports Day, giving everyone, young and old, the opportunity to try out a few of our favourite sports – golf, lawn bowls, tennis and netball. All the events were well attended. I took my youngest, Hannah, to golf and she joined around twenty other kids looking to connect the club with a little white ball. As nighttime hit, kids and grown ups alike rocked out to the ever-popular Well-Strung, in their first island appearance in a few years.

The Flinders Island Sports and RSL Club have asked that I pass on a special thanks to Sammi Gowthorp and Megan Boyes from Council for all their hard work both in the lead up to the event and on the day.

Onto official Council business. Today (22<sup>nd</sup> November), the first Council meeting was held with our newly elected Council. Going forward, Ordinary Council Meetings will be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month at 1pm. A workshop will be held two weeks prior to each meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month.

Also at this meeting, Councillors were elected to each of the various Council Committees and external organisations. Have a look at the Councillor Profiles on the Council website to see which Councillor is heading up or involved with each committee – they are your go to person with any queries or comments.

Just on the subject of committees and community groups, have a think about what events you enjoy, or what groups you rely on. 
