Grant Guidelines

- Please contact the Community Development Team on 6359 5001 to discuss your project before you submit your application.
- Your application must have a clearly stated purpose and a practical plan for achieving the project's goals.
- The project may complement - but should not duplicate - other locally available services.
- Projects must be accessible to individuals living within the Flinders Municipality.
- Where funds are sought for the purchase of equipment, quotes must be included.
- Any risks associated with the project should be identified and considered.
- Flinders Council retains discretion over the total amount allocated to each project.
- Partial funding may be offered if the applicant has indicated they are willing to accept a reduced amount.
- If only partial funding is provided, the applicant will be required to contribute the remaining funds to complete the proposed project.
- Applicants are expected to make some effort toward fundraising or to provide a financial contribution to offset the project costs.
- Successful applicants must acquit the project and submit invoices for approved expenditures within two months of the project's completion to receive reimbursement.
- If modifications to the project are required after approval, any proposed changes must be submitted in writing to the Mayor.

Please Note: Financial assistance will not be provided for:

- Money already spent;
- Salaries or recurrent operational
- Fundraising for future projects.
